#### Antarctica: Changing Ice, Changing World



James B. McClintock is the Endowed University Professor of Polar and Marine Biology at the University of Alabama at Birmingham. Dr. McClintock's research has been funded over the past 33 years, encompassing studies on rapid climate change and ocean acidification on Antarctic marine algae and invertebrates. He recently returned from his 16th research expedition to Antarctica, where he and his research collaborators have become among the world's authorities on Antarctic marine chemical ecology and drug discovery. In October 1998, the United States Board on Geographic Names designated the geographic feature

"McClintock Point" in honor of his contributions to Antarctic science.
